**ACCESS TO DOCUMENTS, DATA PROCESSING, STAFF MEMBER IN CHARGE OF ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE**

Pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679, the personal data provided by candidates will be processed, stored and archived, either physically or digitally, by the University of Trieste, for purposes related to the management of this procedure for fee waivers / reductions. The provision of this data is required for the purposes of assessing the application and failure to provide the required data will result in exclusion from the procedure. The data controller is the University of Trieste, with registered office in Trieste, Piazzale Europa 1.

The data processed for the purposes described above will be communicated to or will, in any case, be accessible to the employees and collaborators of the relevant University offices. These staff members and collaborators are adequately instructed by the Controller.

The University may also communicate personal data it keeps on file to other public administrations should they have to process this data for any procedures falling within their own institutional competence. Similarly, the University is obliged to communicate its data to public entities when mandatorily provided for by EU provisions, laws or regulations, when the relevant prerequisites apply.

The management and storage of personal data collected by the University is conducted using both physical documents and digital documents on servers located within the University and/or on external servers belonging to the suppliers of services necessary for the administrative management. These suppliers may become aware of the personal data of interested parties for the sole purpose of the service they provide and will be duly appointed as Data Processors in accordance with Article 28 of the Regulation.

Students are granted the rights set out in Articles 15-21 of the aforementioned Regulation and, in particular, the right to access their personal data, to ask for it to be rectified, completed and erased, or for restrictions to be placed on its processing.
