L'accertamento finale, oltre al conseguimento dei relativi CFU, comporta anche l'attribuzione di un voto espresso in trentesimi, che concorre a determinare il voto finale di Laurea.

ULTERIORI INFORMAZIONI

Per il conseguimento della Laurea lo studente deve avere acquisito almeno 120 Crediti formativi universitari (CFU) riconosciuti dal Consiglio di Dipartimento e deve avere superato con esito positivo la discussione relativa una prova finale. La prova finale consiste nella preparazione di una tesi in lingua inglese finalizzata ad approfondire un argomento trattato nell'ambito degli insegnamenti svolti durante il Corso di Laurea Magistrale e nella sua discussione in un contraddittorio pubblico. Essa prevede la realizzazione di una attività di ricerca o di analisi di casi e si conclude con la redazione di una tesi, di carattere originale, che dimostri padronanza degli argomenti, capacità di elaborazione autonoma, anche attingendo a concetti, teorie e metodi di discipline differenti, e un buon livello di comunicazione.

PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites for any exam.

ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING OUTCOMES

At the end of each educational activity, students will have to pass an examination. When a student passes an exam, the relevant number of credits will be recorded in their academic record. Examinations may consist of written and/or oral tests (interview, written assignment, written or oral report on the activity carried out, open-ended or multiple-choice questions, performance-based assessment or computer-based testing) defined by the staff member in charge of the activity. When a student passes an examination, they will obtain the relevant ECTS credits. The overall evaluation is expressed in marks out of 30 and the marks of all the required exams will contribute to their final graduation mark.

FURTHER DETAILS

To obtain their degree, students must have acquired at least 120 ECTS credits recognised by the Department Council and must have successfully passed their final examination or defended their thesis. The final examination consists in writing an extensive thesis in English on a subject studied during the master's degree programme and in defending it in public. The student must carry out research or some case studies and deliver an original scholarly paper, demonstrating strong subject knowledge and the ability to work independently, including by drawing on concepts, theories and methods from different disciplines. Good communication skills are also required.
